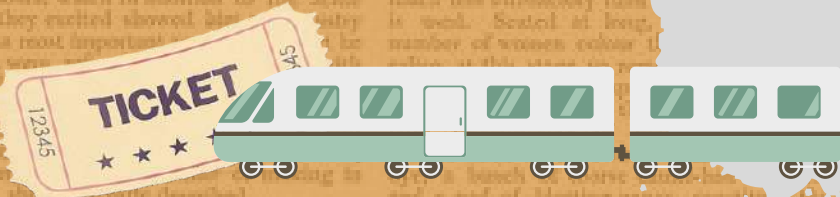
Ganasangamam

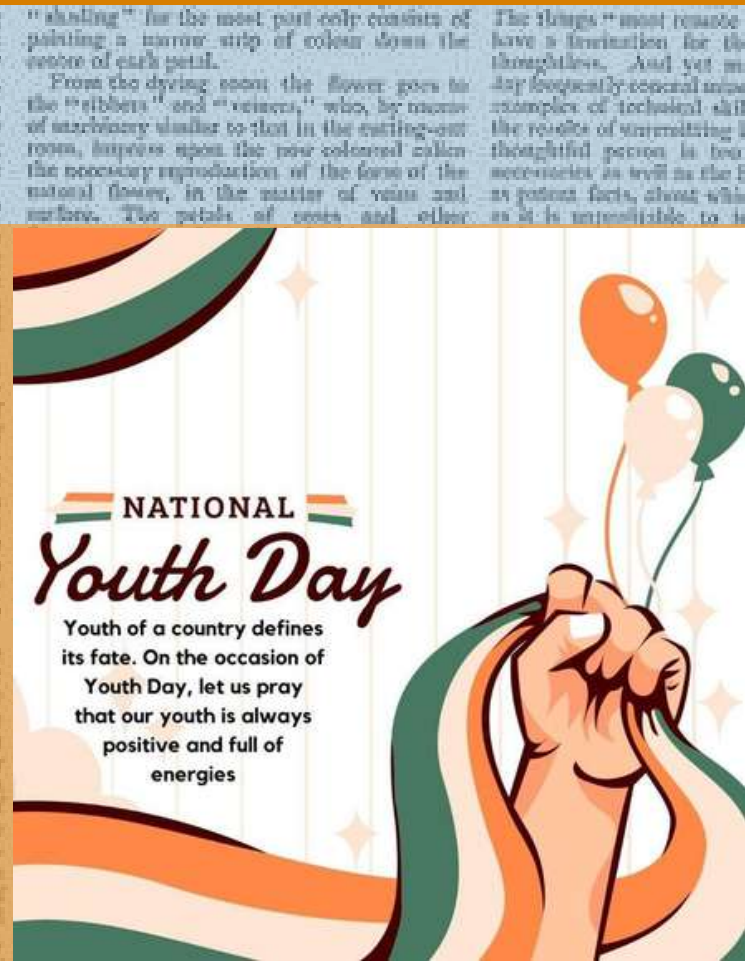

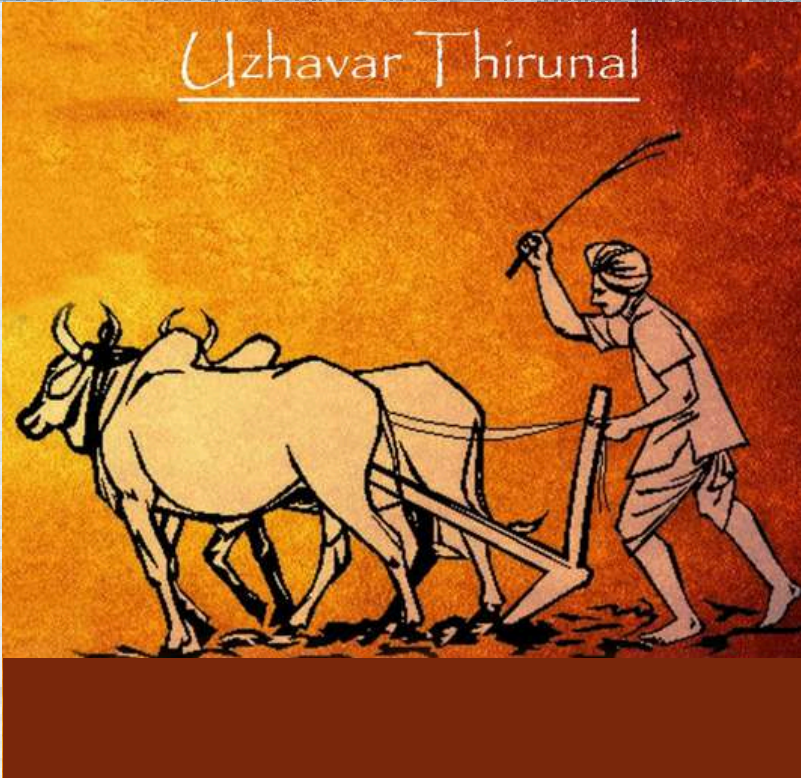


BRV in Kochi

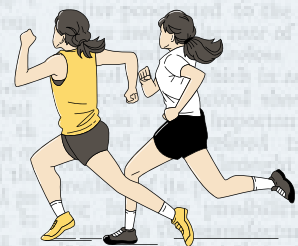


State Athletic Meet

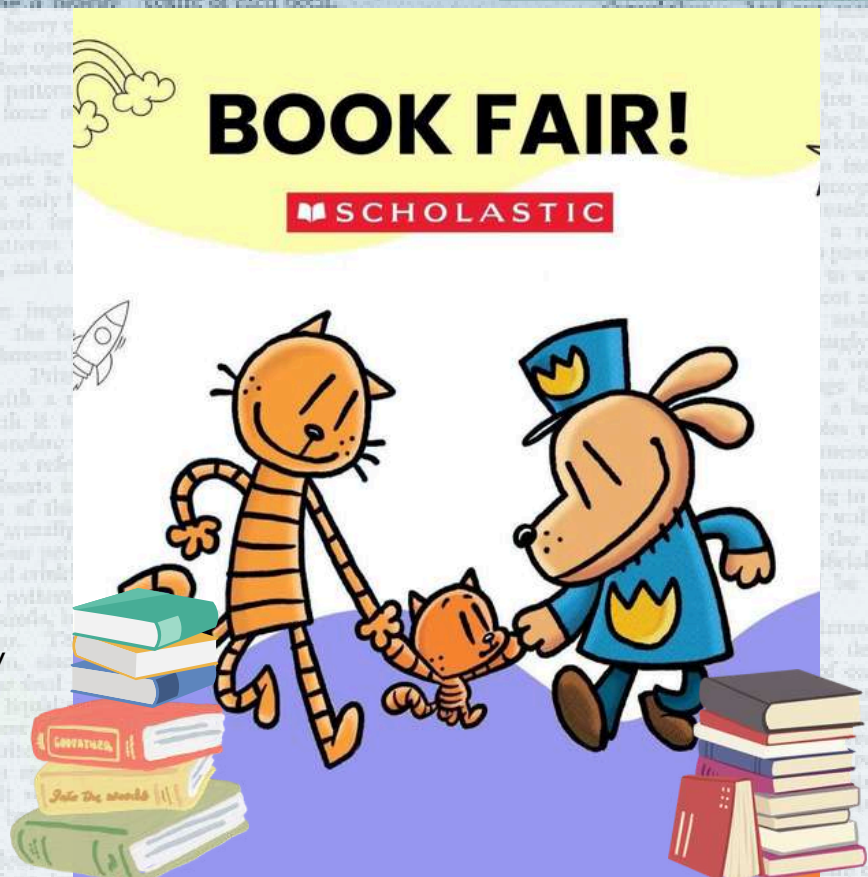
Educational Film

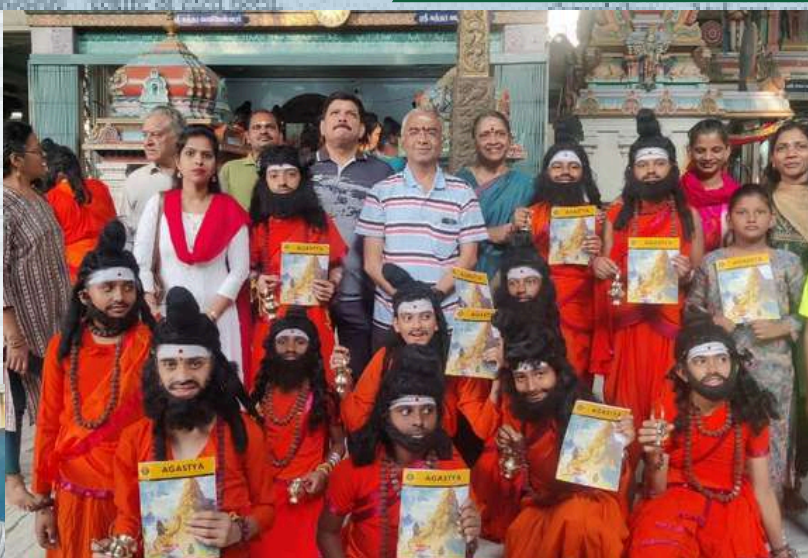
Kola Thamizh Vizha

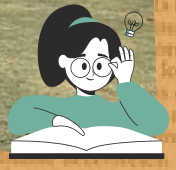


The students were all given a book recounting the sage's life in great detail including the enlightenment attained in the same temple, they were in. It was a marvellous event that was extremely enlightening and informative.

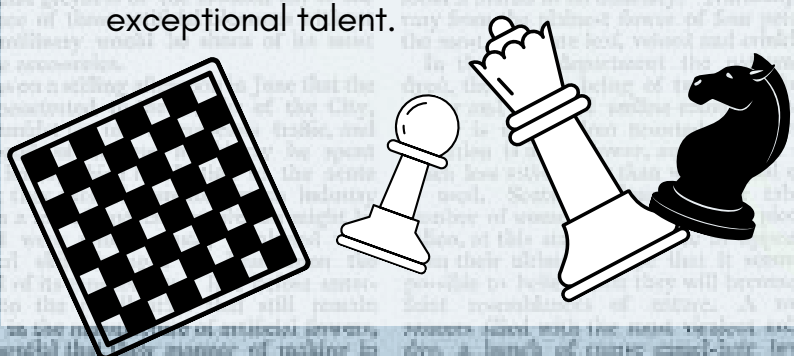
Staff Picnic

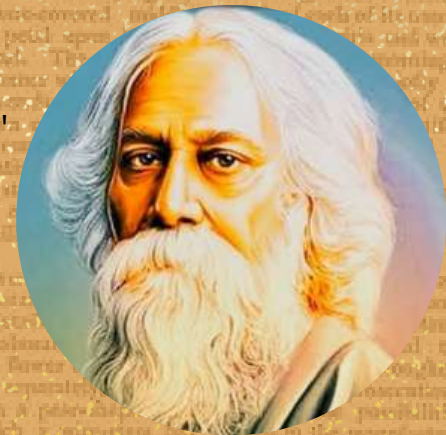

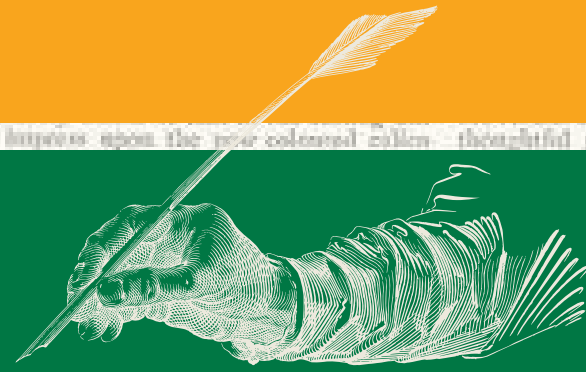

MISSION MARS

Over the years, NASA has sent five robotic vehicles called rovers to Mars. These rovers were named as Sojourner, Spirit, Opportunity, Curiosity and Perseverance.

Sojourner

Sojourner landed on Mars in 1997 in a location called Ares Vallis where it took many images. It drove a short distance and sent more than 550 images of the red planet. The rover used instruments to study about the rocks and dirt. Its lander also collected information on winds and other weather factors on Mars. Do you know that Sojourner Rover was only about the size of a microwave?

Spirit & Opportunity

Spirit & Opportunity landed on January 3rd and 24th 2004 respectively in search of ancient water on the red planet. Designed to last just for 90 days this solar powered rover soldiered for about 6 years and 15 years before succumbing to the planet enveloping dust storm. This mission had confirmed the flow of water, existence of nutrients and previous discovery of the magnetic field that protected the planet from cosmic and solar radiation.

Perseverance

Perseverance landed on Mars on February 18, 2021, and studied a region on Mars called Jezero Crater. This rover shall also test the presence of oxygen on Martian atmosphere helping NASA to send human astronauts one day.

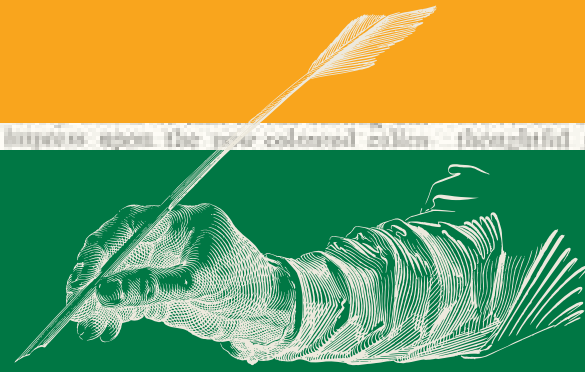
