



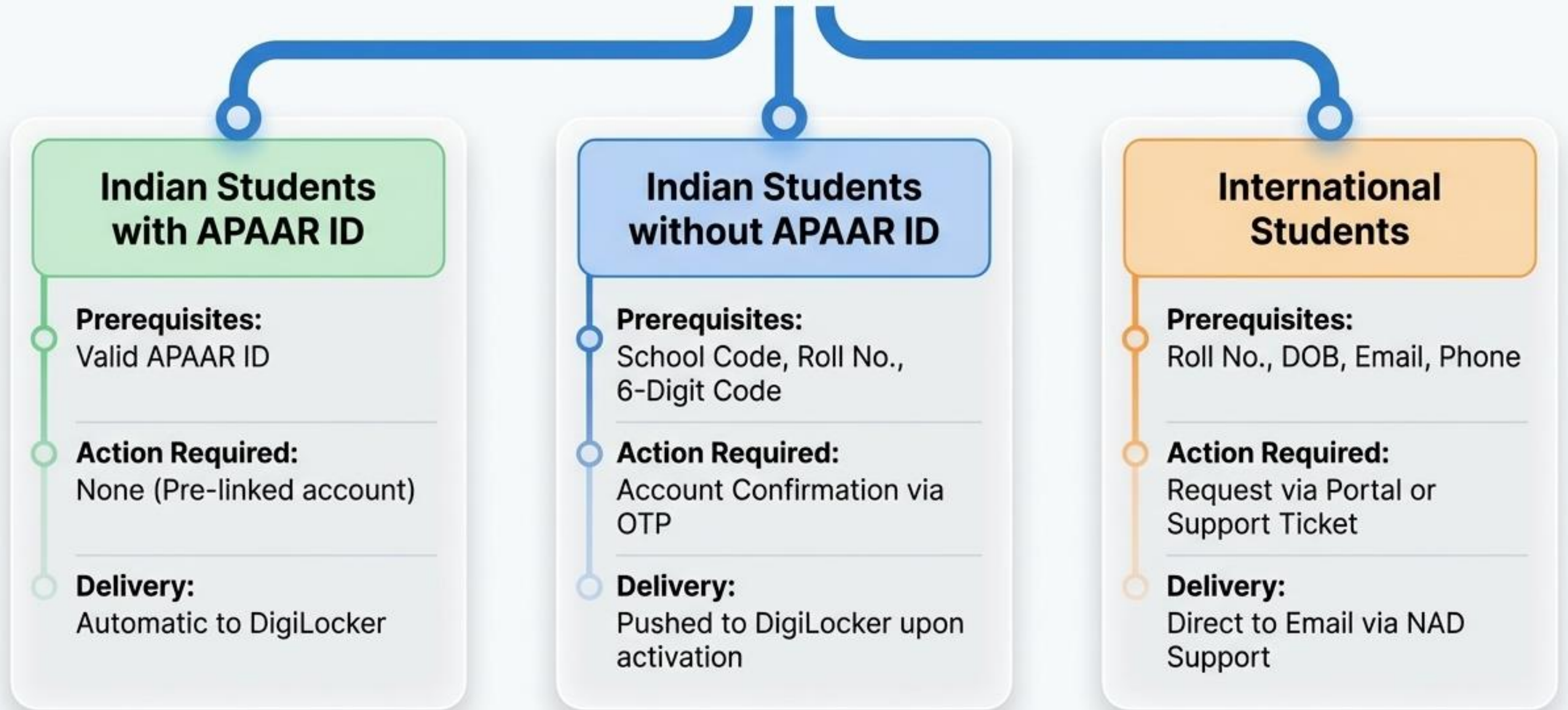

The Result Portal (Shared Starting Point)

<https://results.digilocker.gov.in/>

1. Accessible to both Indian and International CBSE students immediately upon declaration of results.
2. Enter **Roll Number** (e.g., 12345678).
3. Select **Class** (X).
4. Enter **Date of Birth** (DD/MM/YYYY).
5. Click **Submit**.

 **Note:** For Indian students with a valid APAAR ID, viewing results here is optional, as your digital marksheet is already waiting in your DigiLocker.

Four Steps to Account Activation

Before Results are Declared

Post Results



1. Initiate

Visit cbseservices.digilocker.gov.in/activatecbse and click 'Get Started with Account Confirmation'.



2. Verification

Select Class X. Enter School Code, Roll Number, and 6-Digit Access Code.



CRITICAL PIN RULE: Enter numeric values ONLY. If your school provided '012345', you must enter exactly 012345.



3. Mobile Authentication

Enter your 10-digit mobile number and submit the OTP sent to your phone. (Note: Date of Birth may also be requested).



4. Access

Click 'Go to DigiLocker Account'. Marksheets are automatically pushed to the Issued Documents section.

International Students: Two Ways to Access



The Push Method (Email Delivery)

Mechanism:

Request delivery directly from the results portal.

Result:

Marksheet is sent straight to your inbox.

Best for:

Immediate access after viewing results.

OR



The Pull Method (NAD Support)

Mechanism:

Raise a ticket via the DigiLocker NAD Support portal.

Result:

Support team processes and provides the document.

Best for:

Raising an issue and alternative access

Requesting Email Delivery



Step 1: After viewing your result, scroll to the exact footer section and click the link for **Foreign students**.

Step 3: Confirmation. Look for the green success message: **Your requested CBSE marksheet will be sent to your email.**

Raising an NAD Support Ticket

1. Navigate to the DigiLocker NAD Support portal.
2. Create a new support ticket.
3. Ensure you select the specific category: CBSE International Student 2026.
4. Provide your examination details.
5. The DigiLocker / NAD Support Team will process the request and deliver your marksheet and migration certificate per applicable procedures.



One Destination, Absolute Validity



Whether accessed automatically via APAAR, unlocked via a 6-digit code, or delivered via email internationally, the final digital document is identical.

DigiLocker Issued Certificates are legally valid as per the IT Act, 2000.

Your digital marksheet holds the exact same legal weight as a physical paper certificate for all future academic and professional endeavors.
