



## Teachers' Day Competitions



Competitions such as rangoli, hair do, cooking, etc. were held for the teachers and they thoroughly enjoyed participating in the fun filled events.




## Smt. Muthulakshmi




## Aditi Mahapatra

## BSG Camp



## Disha - Teachers' Conference




## Tamil Oratorical Competition
