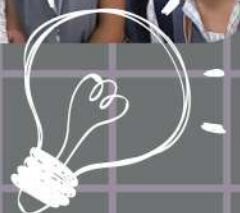

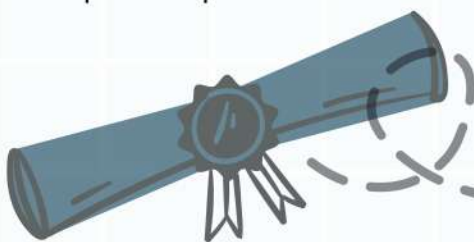
# Hum Ho Gaye Safal

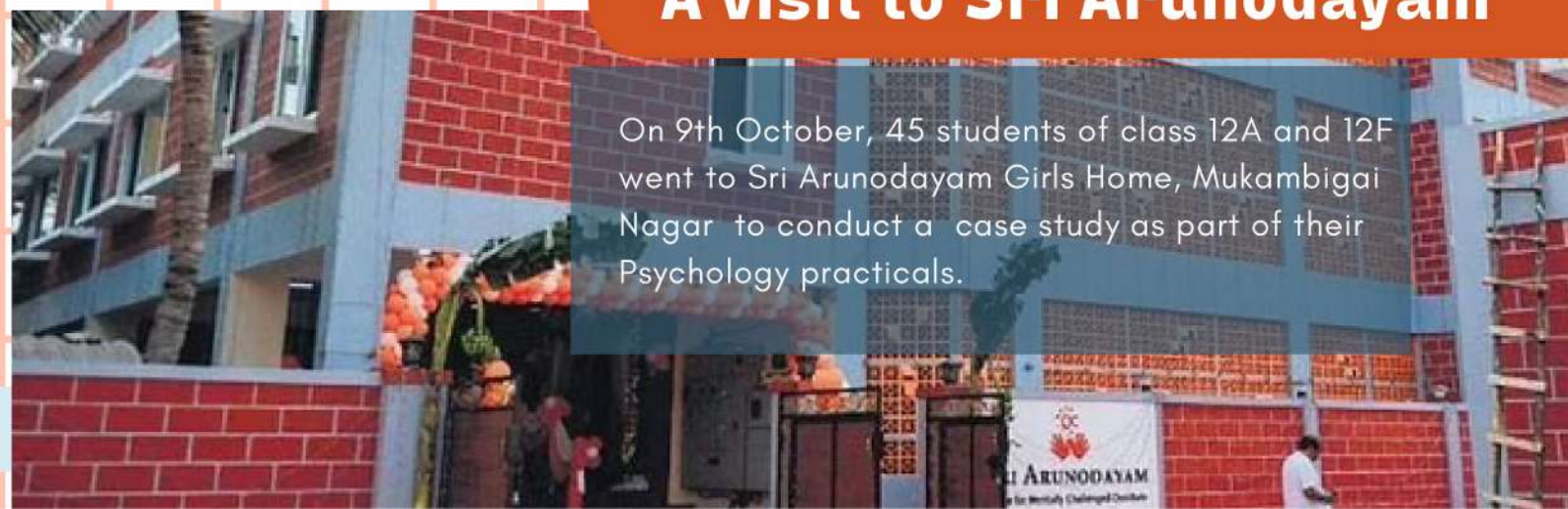

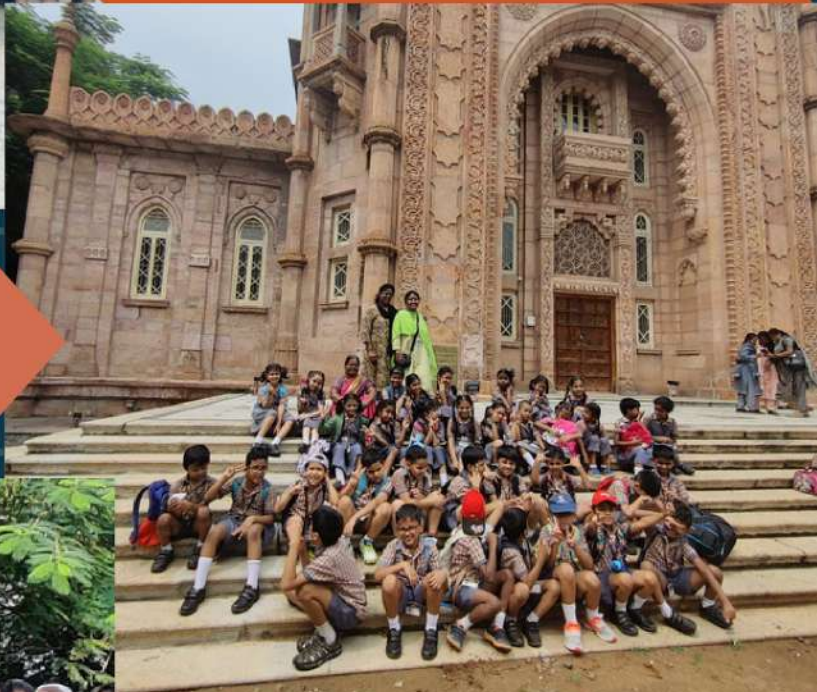
